- pupils/students wanting to develop their knowledge creating research



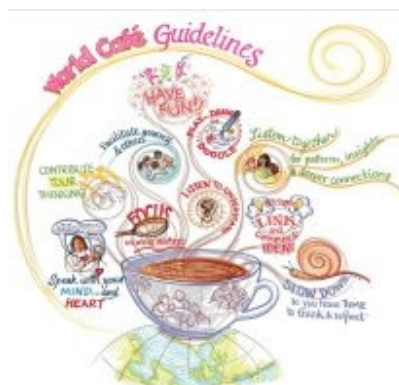
